O'Dowd has ScoMo's ear over private lunch

PRIME Minister Scott Morrison brought his 'ScoMo' bus to Gladstone recently, where he met with Federal Member for Flynn Ken O'Dowd.

Issues Mr O'Dowd brought up with the Prime Minister at a private lunch included:

- The need for more home care packages for the aged.

- The need for more doctors and medical specialists.

- Local jobs.

- Job security, casualisation and labour hire companies.

- Energy prices and the cost of living.

- Water-proofing Flynn – more funding for dams and weirs to secure a more

productive agricultural stream.

- Improved roads and bridges for B-double access.

- Mobile coverage blackspots.

Mr O'Dowd said he had been fighting for Flynn for almost 10 years and had delivered more than \$5 billion for the electorate.
