Flynn's schools encouraged to take action against bullying

Ken O'Dowd has encouraged teachers and school leaders in Flynn to take action against bullying.

Ken O'Dowd said registrations were now open for schools to sign up to the National Day of Action against Bullying and Violence on Friday 15 March 2019.

"The National Day of Action is a national movement against bullying and cyberbullying, and registered schools in Flynn would receive new anti-bullying materials and teaching resources," Ken O'Dowd said.

"The Morrison Government is focused on keeping our kids safe, which means providing support and resources to combat bullies as well as educating everyone about the impact of bullying.

"My message to Flynn's students is get your teachers and principals fired up about taking action against bullying and register to become a National Day of Action school."
